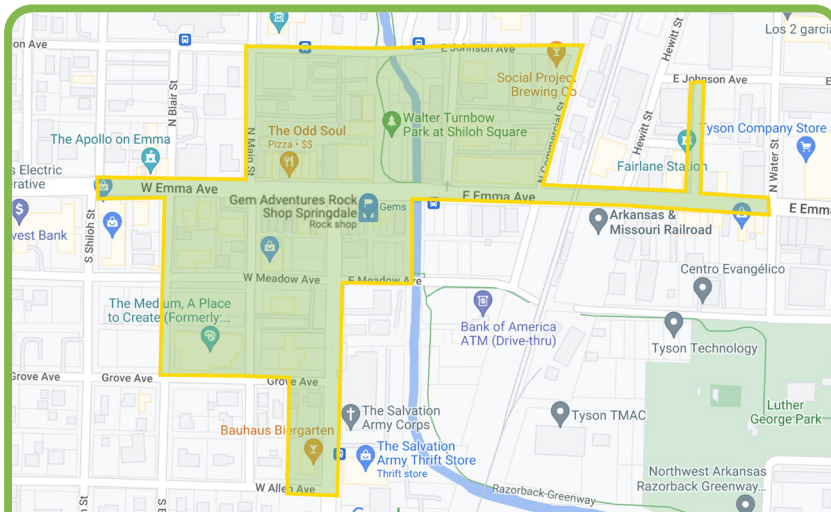
Welcome to the Downtown Springdale Outdoor Dining District! We're keeping it simple:

- Don't bring alcoholic beverages into the district.
- Stay in the boundaries.
- Enjoy Responsibly.
- All designated cups are 100% compostable. Receptacles are available throughout the district to dispose of your cups.
- Can you take alcoholic beverages into different business?

You may bring an alcoholic beverage into another establishment if

- 1) it has a designated window decal and
- 2) it's not also selling alcoholic beverages.

FAQs

Can I bring alcoholic beverages into the Downtown Outdoor Dining District? No. Only drinks purchased from participating businesses within the Downtown Outdoor Dining District are allowed.

What types of alcoholic beverages can I carry? Any alcoholic beverage you buy within the Downtown Outdoor Dining District is allowed to be carried and consumed.

Can I walk anywhere within the Downtown Outdoor Dining District with an alcoholic beverage? Yes. Stroll the sidewalks and enjoy any public spaces within the district. See the map for details.

Can I take alcoholic beverages into Walter Turnbow Park? Most of the time. The City of Springdale may exclude Luther George Park & Shiloh Square from the Outdoor Dining District from time to time, such as for private events or youth focused events.
